Join us to learn more about the Route 621 (Ware House Road) shared use path feasibility study in Gloucester County. The purpose of the study is to evaluate the potential to build a paved shared use path for pedestrians and bicyclists along Ware House Road from Route 17 Business (Main Street) to Ware House Landing Boat Ramp at the Ware River.

The planning study would determine the feasibility and preferred alignment of an approximately two-mile-long proposed path, and costs associated to build a bicycle and pedestrian facility separate from the roadway, which would connect historic Main Street (Gloucester Village) to neighborhoods and recreation on Ware House Road.

The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) is administering the feasibility study with Gloucester County.

Stop by the meeting between 5-7 p.m. to review study materials and preliminary design displays. A brief presentation will be given at 5:30 p.m. Staff will be available to answer questions.
